Who can apply?

Rising seniors (Class of 2023) and those undergraduate students who expect to graduate in 2023 who:

- Have demonstrated leadership at some capacity on and/or off campus.
- Have an interest in, and commitment to, the program.
- Are available for an individual interview (conducted virtually).
- Will be able to participate **all** of senior year.

Application Requirements

To apply for Rockefeller Leadership Fellows, you must submit:

1. The online application.

• Include a brief (150 words or less) bio. <u>Click here for a sample bio.</u>

2. A current professional resume.

3. A written Statement of Interest.

- Guiding questions will be provided in the online application.
- Statement of Interest should be a maximum of two pages, double-spaced.

4. The name and email address of a faculty or staff member

• This should be someone we can contact if we wish to learn more about you.

- Only complete applications with all the supporting documents submitted will be considered.
- Applications submitted after the deadline will not be considered.
- The recruitment process is implemented jointly by Rockefeller Center staff and by the current Rockefeller Leadership Fellows.
- If your application moves to the interview stage, you will be contacted to complete an interview.
